## “THE BLESSING OF ABRAHAM Pt 2” SUNDAY 1/15/23

**SCRIPTURES TO REVIEW:** Look up these scriptures and read them in several translations.

**Galatians 3:16 AMPC.**- Now the promises (covenants, agreements) were decreed *and* made to Abraham and his Seed (his Offspring, his Heir). He [God] does not say, And to seeds (descendants, heirs), as if referring to many persons, but, And to your Seed (your Descendant, your Heir), obviously referring to one individual, Who is [none other than] Christ (the Messiah).

Galatians 3:26, 28

Deuteronomy 28:1

Genesis 12:10

Genesis 13:4-5

Proverbs 10:22

2 Corinthians 8:9

Romans 4:2

2 Corinthians 5:21

- Our foundational scripture Galatians 3:16 tells us that the promises, covenants etc. were made to Abraham AND his seed. His seed being Jesus and we are heirs to every promise of Jesus'. Christ is the seed of Abraham and because of Christ by inheritance, we as Gentiles now share in the Blessing of Abraham. The Jews received the blessing because of being the chosen race.
  - Galatians 3:26- In this season of Blessings and Miracles being released in the earth, it is because of who you are (Seed of Abraham) NOT because of what you have done. “For ye are all the children of God by faith in Christ.” Upon salvation, you were immersed into Christ- Greek- Baptizo, He is on you and in you. You put on Christ AND this blessing. **YOU ARE THE SEED OF ABRAHAM!**
  - Vs. 28- says neither Jew nor Greek, male nor female. Under the New Dispensation of Grace after the cross, you are Abraham’s seed through Christ and have an inheritance of Covenant Blessings. You have been empowered to prosper and have successful outcomes.
  - Deuteronomy 28:1- Pre-Cross/Old Covenant- “it shall come to pass *if thou*, (If indicating conditions- your obedience was the qualification for being blessed, but no one could do it so they sacrificed every year the blood of animals to atone for their sins. If you do good, you get good but if you do bad, you get bad. It was Jesus’ perfect obedience that cause the Believer to be blessed under the New Covenant.
  - Galatians 3:13- that the Blessing of Abraham might come upon the Gentile through Christ Jesus that we might receive the promise through faith! You must renew your mind to this.
  - When the Blessing is on you, the Favor of God is on you and you should EXPECT things to work in your life. Say, “ I put on Christ. I am Blessed. I have successful outcomes.”

Genesis 13:4-5- Abraham went out and so did Lot. Abraham was very rich and Lot got blessed because of

**Association.** Your struggling season is over because of this Blessing! The Lord told Pastor to pronounce Proverbs 10:22 over the congregation and to tell them to mediate on it:

The blessing of the Lord—it makes [truly] rich, and He adds no sorrow with it [**neither does toiling increase it**]. AMPC.

rich= abundantly supplied with not just money. In the above translation this blessing makes one truly rich with no sorrows and you do not have to toil or work to increase it!

Look at other translations;

Message: God's blessing makes life rich;

**nothing we do can improve on God.**

ERV:It is the Lord's blessing that brings wealth, and no hard work can add to it

TLB: The Lord's blessing is our greatest wealth. All our work adds nothing to it!

- Every day believe God for this Blessing and supernatural things!
- 2 Corinthians 8:9 tells us that Jesus though rich, became poor so that he could take on our poverty to make us rich! Through His finished works on the cross, he gave us an empowerment for success "Abundantly supplied."
- Every time you come up against anything if your mindset is renewed you will have successful outcomes because of the blessing!
- YOU MUST have the right mindset to operate in this blessing.
- The seeds of Abraham must have a righteous mindset. Romans 4:2 tells us that when Abraham believed God without works, God declared/justified him as if he never sinned before. You must know you have been declared righteous by God, no sin consciousness- you are able to stand before God knowing this. Vs. 22 indicates so sin was imputed to him or added up and neither to us as Believers! We are justified based on Jesus and our belief in Him!
- 2 Corinthians 5:21 this is our mindset- God made Jesus who knew no sin for us so that we might be made NOT become righteous. God basically, punished Jesus for all of man's sins, past, present and future and treated the Believer as if he lived JESUS' life! THE GREAT SUBSTITUTION! It was the grace of God and complete forgiveness. When God sees the cross, he sees you and when he sees you, he sees Christ! This is the Love of Jesus!
